Crime on the Rise Call Sheriff to Report Crime

Reports regarding break-ins have been coming into the office recently. Items in cars in carports

have been taken. Thieves have taken car registrations and anything else they can find. Make sure car doors are locked and consider installing a camera in your carport to help catch criminals.

Please keep your eyes out for suspicious people and activities. During the

upcoming holiday season, packages are ordered online and delivered to units. If individuals are not careful, packages can be stolen before they can be received. Make sure to track packages, schedule deliveries for when you are going to be home or ask a neighbor to receive packages for you. You should consider having packages sent to your place of work. These options are available through most shipping carriers.

If you think that people might be living in vehicles in our neighborhood, you should call City Code Enforcement or the Sheriff to report suspicious activity. Villa Del Mar HOA staff does not handle these situations.

You can help keep

Street Parking Courtesy Get Closer to Other Vehicles

As we get closer to the holidays, more residents will be having guests visit. As we all know parking is a challenge around Villa Del Mar. When parking on the public street, please try and park as close to other vehicles as possible so we can fit in

as many vehicles as possible. Marked spaces, and other ideas have been proposed, however, they would create less parking due to the mandatory length requirements. So, to help with the parking situation we ask that you do your part and get as

close as possible to other vehicles to make room for more cars.

There have also been numerous complaints of residents with vehicle

that stick out of the dimensions of the carports. As a reminder all vehicles must fit completely in the carport dimensions so that the vehicle doesn't make it difficult for other residents to get into their carports and garages. This is especially true on trash & recycle days.

Owners of any oversized vehicles are requested to pull them all the way into carport areas or park them on the public street. Please make the extra effort to make sure your vehicles do not stick out.

Drain Fly Problems Pest Control Advice

The VDM office has received some calls regarding drain flies and one of our vendors, Balance Pest Control, has some information and advice for residents.

Drain flies are small, about 1/8 inch in length and often dark-colored. They can be found around bathroom and kitchen sinks. They can be hard to get rid of and are often annoying. The key to managing these flies is to eliminate their breeding ground. Start with using a drain brush tool and cleaning inside pipes and garbage disposals. The eggs are laid in the gunk in the pipes and then they hatch and fly around. Use a disinfectant such as a gel drain cleaner or Lysol. Boiling water will not kill the eggs.

If you still have a problem, you may want a plumber to snake out your pipes and call a pest control company to use special products that eliminate the problem.
